





The WKF Karate 1-Series A is a world-class competition that provides karatekas around the world with more competitive opportunities to shine at the highest level. Presented in an open format thus allowing every athlete in the world to compete, the Karate 1- Series A is framed under the umbrella of the Karate 1 to bring together the best competitors in a series of open championships of unprecedented scale and quality. In addition to this, the Karate 1-Series A offers karatekas the chance to increase their ranking position as the universality of top Karate tournaments is showcased.

While maintaining the individual character of each event, all Series A events have to meet certain standards in order to achieve the above-mentioned goals. Therefore, it is necessary to follow these Karate 1 – Series A Organizing Rules 2025.

All members of WKF are admitted participating. The competition categories are identical to those of Senior World Championships except for Kumite team.

The number of competitors for **Kumite** modality is limited to a maximum of 96 athletes per category.

For Kata modality the number of competitors is limited to a maximum of 128 athletes.

The WKF Competition Rules in force will be applied.

Competitors of individual categories earn ranking points in every WKF Karate1 event according to the official <u>WKF World Ranking regulations</u>.



# 9. RANKING

Competitors can earn ranking points in every Karate 1 event according to the official WKF Event Ranking as can be seen in Section 2 (Points per Place) and Section 3 (Points Calculating System) of the <u>WKF Ranking Rules</u>.

The participation will be limited to those competitors from position 33 onwards of the WKF Event Ranking.

The **Event Ranking** is defined as a **static file** which reflects on the ranking on the opening day of the online registration for a given event: 28/10/2024.

# **10. ONLINE REGISTRATION & OFFICIAL ACCREDITATION**

Registration starts on October 28<sup>th</sup>, 2024, and closes fifteen (15) days before the tournament on December 25<sup>th</sup>, 2024 at 12:00 hrs GMT +0

All registration in a Series A event must be processed ONLINE.

No registration will be accepted after the official online registration deadline and all requests will be declined.

#### Onsite registrations will NOT be accepted.

Registrations subjected to the payment of a registration fee will not be validated until the payment is completed through the online payment platform.

#### Onsite payments will NOT be accepted.

Individuals and National Federations are responsible for the quality of the entered registration data.

The online registration will be openly disclosed for everyone from the beginning, allowing consultation by WKF NFs of the events' participants registered in real time.

Any issue regarding the online registration has to be notified to the software provider and to the WKF, latest five days before the first day of competition, in order to allow taking them in consideration without altering the smooth running of the process.

# **10.1 Athletes Registration**

The participation will be limited to those competitors from position 33 onwards of the WKF Event Ranking.

Athletes' registration is divided in the following two phases (all phases will close at the 12:00 hrs GMT +0 of the listed day)

- **Phase 1, from 28/10 to 11/11, 2024 (first two weeks)**: Registration only by National Federations only for athletes ranked between position 33 and 100 (included) of WKF Event Ranking (first two weeks of registration). Maximum, 1 athlete per category.
- Phase 2, from 12/11 to 25/12: Open registration.

# **10.2 Referees Registration**

REFEREE REGISTRATION

After accessing the registration page, you will need to choose your registration group:

- Referees with WKF and/or Continental License: the WKF reserves its right to stop the registration once the number of registered referees with WKF and/or Continental License has reached the number of 90.
- Referee Commission members
- Referees ranked within the top 30 of the WKF Referee Ranking on the opening date of registration for each event.
- NF Referees without WKF and/or Continental License

The Referee Ranking applicable for the Tbilisi 2025 Series A will be the one on the opening day of the online registration, 28/10/2024.

Referee registration will open on October 28<sup>th</sup> at 12:00 h GMT+0 and close on December 25<sup>th</sup> at 12:00 h GMT +0.

#### **10.3 Coaches Registration**

The minimum level required to perform as a coach in Series A events is the WKF Accredited Coach Certification (Coach level 1).

All coach registrations must be made ONLINE:

# **10.4 Official Onsite Accreditation**

The onsite official accreditation session will take place on January 9<sup>th</sup>, 2025 from 10h to 17h at HQ Hotel Holiday Inn.

If changes are required during the official registration session because of incorrect or missing registration data, a fee of € 50 is charged for each change.

The athlete's accreditation must contain an updated photograph that allows the athlete to be identifiable throughout the event.

Accreditation cards will be issued at registration, displaying the participants' main data, a photograph and information about registered categories. The accreditation card must be carried at all times during the event.

Only members of national federations recognized by WKF are admitted to participating, following the registration procedures described in Series A Organising Rules (SA OR Point 6 Registration).

All participants must submit an official passport for the WKF identification and validation at the accreditation session.

The accreditation of any competitor must be done by the athlete or the athlete's coach, in person bringing the athlete passport at the accreditation session.

Any competitor who may not have collected their accreditation during official registration, either personally or through their delegate, WILL NOT BE INCLUDED IN THE DRAW.


# **15. COMPETITION VENUE**



### 20.1 About Tbilisi

#### **About City**

The capital city Tbilisi is situated on the banks of the Kura River, in the heart of Georgia. This vibrant urban center is renowned for its rich history that spans over centuries. Its roots can be traced back to ancient times, with evidence of human habitation dating back to antiquity. The city's evolution has been influenced by various civilizations, including the Greeks, Romans, Persians, and Byzantines. Tbilisi's true emergence occurred during the 5th century when it became an important trade and cultural hub along the Silk Road.

# 20.2 How to get to Tbilisi City

#### By Airplane

Tbilisi is served by the Tbilisi International Airport (TBS), which has connections to various international destinations. You can book flights directly to Tbilisi or connect through major European and Middle Eastern airports. Once you land at the airport, you can easily reach the city center using taxis, airport shuttles, or ride-sharing services.

There is also other airport that you can consider (with low cost airline options): Kutaisi International airport is 250 km away from Tbilisi city centre, which evens approximately four hours by car.

#### **Financial Services and Banking Hours**

Regular banking hours are Monday to Friday from 10:00 to 18:00, on Saturday from 10:00 to 14:00. All banks are closed on Sunday, and national holidays.

Major credit cards are accepted in most business establishments.

Most shops and restaurants will accept major international credit cards e.g. Visa, MasterCard, American Express Card.

Local markets accept cash only.



# TAXES

VAT(18 %) is collected in the entire country for all services and products. Tax free shopping is available to international guests only at licensed stores. A passport is required when shopping tax free.

### Georgian TAX FREE shopping rules are:

- 200 GEL from one shop at one time.
- You may not use the product before tax free inspection.
- The tax return is only partial, not the full 18 % VAT.
- You have to leave Georgia within 3 months of the purchase.
- You need a stamped and signed VAT refund receipt from the seller.
- The product must be in a plastic or a paper bag sealed by the seller.
- You must exit the country from an International airport (Tbilisi, Kutaisi or Batumi)

#### Location

Georgia is located in the South Caucasus region of Eurasia, bordered by Russia to the north, Azerbaijan to the southeast, Armenia to the south, and Turkey to the southwest. It also has a coastline along the Black Sea to the west.

### Weather

Tbilisi has a diverse climate with distinct seasons. During the the Championship temperature is between -3°C to 8°C.

### Time Zone

Georgia is in the Georgian Standard Time (GET), which is UTC+4.

#### 21.4 Local Law

In Tbilisi, the legal age for most activities is 18 years. Laws are enforced by local police, and it's important to carry identification at all times.



Driving in Tbilisi follows the right-hand traffic system. The use of seat belts is mandatory for all occupants of a vehicle. Speed limits are set at 60 km/h within urban areas and 90 km/h on rural roads. Visitors are encouraged to exercise caution during peak traffic hours due to congestion and to be mindful of varying road conditions.

### 21.6 Alcohol

The legal drinking age in Georgia is 18 years. Alcohol consumption is permitted in designated areas, though public intoxication may result in fines. Georgian wine and spirits are widely available, and it is customary to engage in social drinking during meals and festive occasions

#### 21.7 Tobacco

The legal age for the purchase of tobacco products in Georgia is 18 years. Smoking is prohibited in enclosed public spaces, including restaurants and bars, with designated smoking areas provided for compliance. Adherence to these regulations is generally observed throughout the city.

#### 21.8 Safety in the city

Tbilisi is considered a safe destination for visitors. In recent years, Tbilisi has welcomed millions of tourists and has hosted several international events
