2. INTRODUCTION

A total of 80 teams, 20 teams per modality/category (Kumite and Kata / Male and Female), can qualify with limitation of one team per country per modality/category for the World Cup.

The World Cup - Competition System is composed by the Group Phase (Round-robin, R-r), Quarter-Finals, Semi-Finals and medal matches. Each category will be awarded 1 gold, 1 silver and 1 bronze.

3. COMPETITION INFORMATION

3.1 Modalities/Categories

	Team Kata	Team Kumite
Male	4 Athletes per team (3 + 1 sub)	7-8 Competitors per team (5 + 2 compulsory sub. + max. 1 optional subs.)
Female	4 Athletes per team (3 + 1 sub)	4-5 Competitors per team (3 + 1 compulsory sub. + max. 1 optional sub)

In kumite the men's team must consist of minimum 7, and maximum 8, Competitors.

In kumite the woman's team must consist of minimum 4, and maximum 5, Competitors.

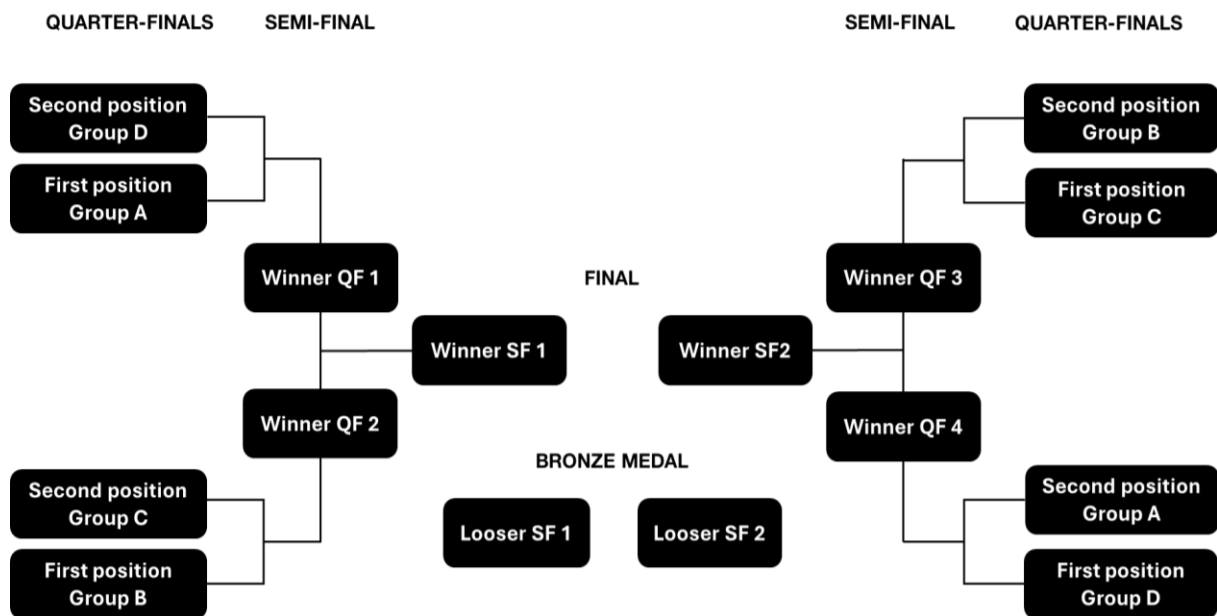
3.2 Competition System

Group Phase

There will be a total of 20 teams divided into 4 groups resulting in 5 teams per group.

Elimination Phase

After the Group Phase, the two first classified teams in each group qualify to the Quarter-Finals where the bout winners head to the Semi-Finals and the losers of the Semi-Finals head to the bronze medal match, and the winners to the Final.

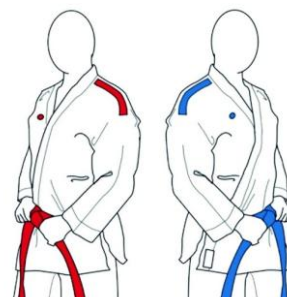

12. REFEREES

The minimum level required for referees to register and officiate at Karate World Cup is:

“Kumite Referee A and Kata Judge A”.

The Referees categories allowed to register in Hangzhou World Cup - (see “[Conditions and Requirements for Referees 2026](#)”) are listed below;

- a. WKF Referee Commission
- b. The WKF will appoint 30 Officials according to the criteria described below;
 - Highest WKF license Kumite Referee-A and Kata Judge-A
 - Compliance with the Referees’ requirements for attending a Karate World Cup, including one extra Premier League
 - Activity attendance according to the WKF Referee Ranking
 - Universality (Continental Federations)

The list of the appointed referees will be published before the start of the online registration on 15th July.

- c. NFs will be allowed to register a maximum of TWO referees per NF that complies with the overall established annual requirements, regardless of those nationalities already included with those appointed by the WKF under points a) and b) above.

The online registration will start on 15 July 2026 at 12:00 (GMT +0) and will close on 1 October 2026 at 12:00 (GMT +0).

All registrations in a Karate World Cup must be processed online.

No registration will be accepted after the official online registration deadline.

The WKF Karate One-Premier League Hangzhou 2025, the Karate event of the 19th Asian Games Hangzhou as well as the 20th Asian Senior Karate Championship and the 3rd Asian Para Karate Championship were held in this gymnasium.

21. THE HOST CITY

21.1 About Hangzhou



The capital city of Zhejiang province and its economic, cultural, science and educational center, Hangzhou is one of the central cities in the Yangtze River Delta. A popular City of Scenic Tourism, it also ranks among the first batch of National Historical and Cultural Towns. Located in the southern wing of the Yangtze River Delta, western tip of the Hangzhou Bay, it is the crossing point of the extension of "Silk Road Economic Belt" and "21st Century Maritime Silk Road" and a strategic hub along the "Online Silk Road".

Situated at the juncture of 29°11'-30°34' North and 118°20'-120°37' East, Hangzhou features a perfect blending of hill and water, and lake and town, with rich water resources, and a ubiquitous yet harmonious presence of rivers, canals, lakes, sea, creeks. Such picturesque natural view has earned the fame of "Paradise on Earth" for millenniums. Throughout its territory, hilly or mountainous areas account for 65.6% and are largely concentrated in the west, middle and south; plains amount to 26.4%, mainly found in the northeast; surface area of rivers, lakes and reservoirs takes up 8.0%. Its forest coverage ranks top among the nation's provincial capitals - up to 65.33%. Hangzhou boasts the largest reservoir in China's southern coast - the Xin'an River Reservoir (also known as Qiandao Lake) and the world's longest artificial canal - the Beijing-Hangzhou Grand Canal. Traversing the city is Qiantang River, widely known for its spectacular tidal waves.

22. HOW TO GET TO THE WORLD CUP

22.1 By Air

Hangzhou International Airport (HGH) is located in the east of Hangzhou City, Zhejiang Province, 27 kilometers away from the city centre, and is the first air portal of Zhejiang Province as it is an important trunk-line airport, an international scheduled flight airport, a first-class airport open to the outside world and alternate airport for international flight in China.

23.2 Currency

The Chinese yuan renminbi (simplified Chinese: 人民币), or CNY, which means 'people's currency', is the official currency of the People's Republic of China.

However, for payment method, China is primarily a cashless and cardless economy, with the vast majority of shoppers using their phones (digital wallets) to pay for items in person and online. Digital wallets WeChat Pay and Alipay are China's two most popular payment methods, accounting for more than 90 per cent of the mobile payments market. Meanwhile UnionPay is the only card scheme in China, it issues debit and credit cards, links all ATMs in the country, provides merchants with EPOS (electronic points of sale) machines, and offers online and mobile payment services.

23.3 Electricity

In China, power plugs and sockets (outlets) of type A, type C and Type I are used. The standard voltage is 220 V at a frequency of 50 Hz.



23.4 Language

The official language for China is Chinese.

23.5 Time

Time zone in Hangzhou, Zhejiang Province, China (GMT+8).

23.6 Weather

Hangzhou enjoys a subtropical monsoon climate, featuring distinct seasons, ample sunlight and rainfall, shorter in spring and autumn, and longer in winter and summer. The average temperature in the urban area is about 18.5 °C, a total precipitation of 1,502.7 mm, and a total sunshine of 1,943.1 hours. An extreme high temperature] of 43.7 °C, and a lowest temperature of -5.0°C. The average temperature in Hangzhou in March is 8 °C -17 °C, and in October it is 16 °C -24 °C.
