The EKF Cadet, Junior & U21 Championships LIMASSOL 2026 will be held next February, 6-8 in Limassol Cyprus.

## 3. CITY / COUNTRY INFORMATION

### 3.1 About City

Limassol, also known as Lemesos, is the second-largest city in Cyprus and is located on the southern coast of Cyprus and serves as the capital of the Limassol district. With a population of approximately 195,139 in the urban area and 262,238 in the district, it is a bustling hub of activity and commerce.

The city is situated between two ancient cities, Amathus and Kourion, and has a rich historical background dating back to antiquity. Beyond its modern infrastructure, Limassol is a place with deep historical roots. Here you'll find archaeological sites such as Kolossi Castle and the ancient Kourion theater, which testify to the glorious civilization of the region.

Is full of life, with an impressive coastal promenade, its picturesque old port, and its marina offering countless options for relaxation and entertainmen

Our city is famous for its warm hospitality and gastronomy, with traditional Cypriot taverns and modern restaurants catering to every taste. Limassol is also known for its intense athletic activity and for its Carnival, which is one of the most famous in all of Europe.

### 4. HOW TO GET TO Limmasol

## 4.1.1 Flight

Cyprus can only be reached by **air** via two international airports in the Republic of Cyprus. Larnaca (LCA) and Paphos (PFO), which have frequent direct flights from major European cities.

The distance to Limassol from Larnaca Airport is **around 67 km** and from Paphos Airport is **around 85 km**.

All travellers must enter the Republic of Cyprus **ONLY** via the official Airports of Larnaca and Pafos.

There are three ways to travel between the two Airports to Limassol city: Airport taxi, private transfer, or shuttle bus.

#### 4.2 Practical Information

### Language

The main language spoken in Cyprus is Greek and although not the official language, English is widely spoken, especially among younger people and in major tourist areas, hotels, and restaurants.

#### Weather

February is the final month of Cyprus's winter season. Therefore, holiday-makers in Limassol should expect some relatively cold weather. Average temperatures are around 12°C (54°F), with highs reaching 16°C (61°F) and lows sinking to around 8°C (46°F) at night, so packing some warmer clothes could be useful.

#### **Shop Opening Hours**

Shop opening hours vary, depending on their type and location and whether they are located in urban, tourist or rural areas. Generally, during the Winter period, shops will open around 08:00 – 09:00 a.m. and close at 20:00 on Monday – Saturday.

In most of the tourist areas of Cyprus, both shops and supermarkets stay open till late at night, and are also open on Sundays.

Malls are open

#### **Electricity**

Cyprus uses power plugs and sockets of **type G**, with a standard voltage of 230 V and a frequency of 50 Hz. If your devices are compatible with these specifications, you will not need a power adapter

#### **Local Law**

The legal system of Cyprus is primarily based on English common law and equity jurisdiction, having preserved much of the English law after gaining independence in 1960. It operates



under an adversarial model of justice and is considered business-friendly, ensuring transparency and reliability in legal practices. The court system includes various specialized courts, such as family courts, rent control courts, and industrial disputes tribunals, which handle specific types of cases. Additionally, the legal framework is influenced by European law, contributing to its complexity and adaptability. Overall, the Cypriot legal system is characterized by its codification and the principle of precedent, making it effective and fair.

### **Vehicle Driving**

Vehicles are right hand drive and driving is done on the left side of the road.

#### Alcohol

Alcohol is only served and sold to people over 18 years of age. The consumption of alcohol is illegal under 18 years of age

#### Tobacco

No smoking or vaping is allowed in inside areas at any venue

Cyprus is generally considered a safe destination for travelers, with low crime rates and a welcoming culture, but it's important to stay informed and take basic precautions by keeping your belongings safe in your hotel room and when out in restaurants and bars.

#### 10.1 Course for EKF Coaches

Please find below all information of the Programme for EKF Coaches that is going to be taking place in Limassol (Cyprus) on occasion of the EKF Karate Cadet, Junior & U21 Championships 2025.

The minimum level required for coaches to take part in EKF Championships is the:

"EKF Kumite/Kata Coach" certification (coach level 2)

It is possible to homologate a WKF Kumite and/or Kata Coach (coach level 2) license by the EKF, only during the online registration period, until 12<sup>th</sup> January 2026. After this date no homologations will be accepted.



To do so, you must fill in the form: "Request for the Homologation of a WKF Coach Certification by the EKF" and send it to the e-mail; <a href="mailto:ekf@ekf.com.es">ekf@ekf.com.es</a>, together with the bank proof of payment of the homologation fee.

After receiving the written approval of EKF homologation, you can register to officiate as a coach at the event.

Note: The WKF Accredited Coach license (coach level 1) is not homologated by the EKF.

For those withing to obtain a EKF Coach license, successful participation in the EKF Coaches' course is required.
